Mountains to the Sea is a time-speed-distance tour-style road rally. The rally route instructions are easy to follow. Numbered route instructions are accompanied by mileage. Speeds are set at or below legal speed limits. Pauses are provided where needed.

The approximately 200-mile route takes about 7 hours to complete. About a third of that time is on transits and breaks. Roads used on the rally route are paved, with the exception of two short sections totaling less than nine miles that are smooth, hard, unpaved surface.

About the rally

The April rally was a bit longer than the average Saturday Series Rally, with a 120-mile course that took just under four hours to complete.

The tour-style rally moved along at a steady pace so you always felt you were on your way to...well, somewhere. Despite the course doubling back and retracing routes used earlier in the rally and even running some of the same roads backwards. Seamless.

A break to transit through Hockinson and stop at the vintage market or the gas station convenience store was followed by the featured stop on this road rally, a visit to Lucia Falls Park.

There were no navigational or time-keeping challenges, other than those created by the rallyists themselves or their equipment. Well, there was one ITIS (if there is such) route instruction that directed a 0.1-minute pause at a STOP. You came to a railroad crossing that has a stop sign. If you decided to execute that instruction at the

railroad crossing, then you gave yourself a 10-point penalty.

The correct action was to skip the ITIS instruction (and its penalty pause) because the railroad crossing does not meet the definition of a STOP in the Road Rally Rules which says a STOP is an intersection of rally roads controlled by a stop sign at which you must stop. Since the railroad crossing is not an intersection, you cannot use the instruction there.

There was one team that fell behind the pack almost immediately after leaving the end of the odometer calibration section. They came back to the end of the odo and restarted twice. Turns out they were struggling with a rally equipment malfunction. They eventually caught up and joined us at the restaurant.
